# FEBRUARY'S SPEAKER- PAT DORNICK

## Calibrated Energy Therapy

This workshop will instruct the participants on specific techniques and processes that can promote a stabilization of our own human energy fields by building and strengthening its capacity to hold greater amounts of light.

Through the experience of guided meditations we can begin to understand the term "dimensional reality". Our physical mind is a complex sensory instrument that receives and interprets data from our superconscious, and subconscious mind levels. This data is sent to the various levels of our conscious mind for our interpretation and construct of our own personal realities.

It is vital to understand that as we grow, we begin to integrate greater levels of light into our daily lives. Techniques for clearing and communication change as we grow into a higher level of light (initiation/learning). We need to use the appropriate tools for the level of light we are in.

We all must constantly update the process and tools we use to understand and begin to integrate our consciousness into higher frequencies of light and growth in our personal life.

When we recognize that the current tools we are using no longer support us, we need to work with clearing and releasing the old beliefs and habit patterns that are limiting our ability to access our own light. As our soul work evolves we grow in consciousness and abilities so that we can work within our own light. We can then gain access to clear ourselves of elements that held us from the light.

Our consciousness is learning to understand that it is merely working toward remembering and accepting itself as Part of its own God Self and that when we are ready to receive and as we accept this fuller richer Light in our life, we will ultimately become the Light.

This workshop is one of several in this series that begins a unique study, which offers fundamental skills to help integrate this work at our 3rd dimensional level. Learning to incorporate our dowsing skills and practicing how to ask the "right questions" as we are able to discern the appropriateness of our activity.

This workshop begins to give people a level of Soul awareness so they can begin to perceive how/when their Light body communicates with their physical body to allow them to recognize when to update their tools.

As we grow and are permitted to work with this knowledge we learn to open to our awareness. This information must first go into Super conscious mind then into the subconscious mind and then to our physical mind before we can use it at our conscious mind level. ## PRESIDENT'S CORNER

If I've learned anything in this dowsing thing it is that you never know what's coming, so as the native people say, "stay awake; pay attention!". The other day I was dowsing for a well site for an old friend (and fellow member), Carlo Marzella, when he gifted me with an amazing little book by Japanese researcher Samaru Emoto, saying that it had literally changed his life.

Coming from Carlo, that meant "pay attention!", so I dove into it immediately. recalling that I had heard somewhere of this man's quiet work on the crystalization of water molecules specifically how this is effected by the energy of the surroundings. The book's title: "The Secret Messages In Water". What I discovered, as I am sure has occurred with Carlo and other dowsers, has astounding implications not only for dowsing as such, but for prayer, healing and our very thinking and presence in the world.

Emoto, having developed a method for photographing and studying the infinite variety of frozen water crystals, has found to his astonishment, that their intricate structure and

beautiful design (or lack thereof) are a direct result of the most subtle influences imaginable on water, such as our thoughts and feelings, words (both printed and spoken) and actions (polluting, for example). In fact, he concludes that water, which is both the origin and essence of life itself and which composes 70% of our bodies, is a vast and perfect storehouse of information ("messages") on everything in existence - even in history, whether ours or the planet's, and even regarding the origin of life in the Universe.

The point for dowsers, I think, is that this wealth of information can be accessed - at the asking. But there's much more. Emoto has proven visually with photographic images that we can change the energy of water



(the content of its "messages") with our intention - by prayer, ritual and ceremony, in short, and thereby heal. He finds consistently that the most effective words for empowering our intention are "gratitude" and "love", no matter what language they are spoken or written in. Perhaps the healing waters of the sacred sites of legend are no joke after all. Nor is the purification of polluted water at a distance. A case in point: suppose we ask that the polluted water threatening the lives of the survivors of the recent SE Asian tsunamis be purified, even made into a universal healing agent? Who was it that said "Ask, and you shall receive"?

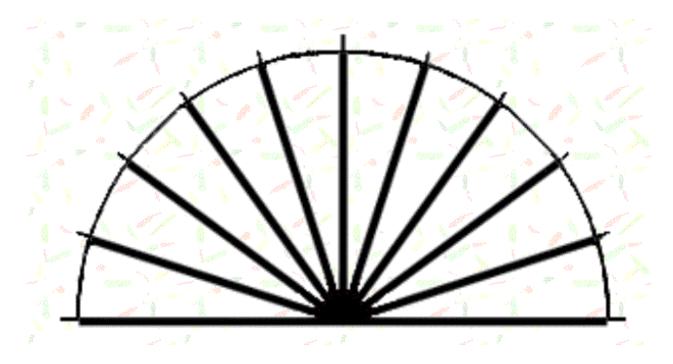

#### Dowsing Tips and Quips from RIP (Reason, Intuition, Psyche)

# GETTING TO WARREN WILSON -COLLEGE

\*Driving east on I-40 take Exit # 55, go underneath the interstate and turn R onto Hwy 70 and go east for two miles. Turn L at the first traffic light onto Warren Wilson Rd, and go 1.5 miles to the campus. Continue straight up the hill past the first entrance to the campus on your right to the intersection at the top. Turn L, onto Chapel Dr. The WWC chapel is straight ahead. Park in the lot or on the road to the left of the chapel. Fellowship Hall is behind the chapel, off the back end of it. Enter the Hall via a walkway along the right side of the chapel or off the road on the left side, where you will have to follow a path up to the ground level.

If you are driving west on I-40, take Exit # 59, turn R, go to the traffic light and turn L onto Hwy 70. Proceed west on Hwy 70 for about three miles and turn R at the traffic light onto Warren Wilson Rd. Then follow the above directions into campus and on to the Presbyterian chapel.
