

President's Corner

2013 ASD National Convention Report

I would especially like to thank the Chapter for helping me attend the 2013 ASD National Convention in June, with VP Brian Crissey. This was a great opportunity to get to know Brian better; as we found out we have had a lot in common over the years. It is amazing to find someone who has dedicated his life in the pursuit of Truth as have I.

The 53rd Annual Convention was entitled "Dowsing the Golden Age - A Sacred Shift." My immediate reaction was I am in for a wild ride and I had high hopes that I would learn exactly what is needed for my Highest Good and for the Good of others.

On Friday morning, I helped Brian set up the Crop Circle essences table and I started to make my rounds to meet all the vendors and speakers. My first workshop was Brian's "Communication with Energy Beings by Dowsing Crop Circles". He had asked me to video his presentation so we would have a backup to the DVD that the conference staff made. He was well received, with some repeat folks from last year.

During lunch and the other meals, we made a point to sit with different folks so we could talk about our Chapter and our Southern Region Conference (which I found out includes 14 states) in the Fall of 2014. Right from the start we were received very well. Everyone loves the Asheville area and is eager to participate in our conference. It is amazing what you can get done during a meal with fellow dowsers.

My second workshop on Friday was entitled "The Golden Banquet: The Alchemy of Food and Nourishment" taught by Nancy Lee Bentley, holistic food expert, author, and minister of healing. Now, I had picked another workshop but I decided to dowse and attend the one that was in my highest good. I have a great interest in this subject as you can tell by looking at me and I thought I knew a lot about nutrition. However, I soon learned that there is a 'New Paradigm', a new 'Golden Age of Consciousness' in which we can dowse and know the energy, frequency and the love foundation of the 'True Nourishment' that can help nurture us as

Whole Beings, enabling truly integrated health on all levels. I learned that 'Frequency' is the most important food, of which high quality live foods, good digestion with probiotics, high quality water, trace minerals, and stable blood sugar are key components. She also suggested reading Bruce Lipton's Book "Biology of Belief" and Candace Pert's "Biology of Emotions". Always question the status quo; we are each unique beings fully capable of becoming Light Beings ushering in the Golden Age of Consciousness.

On Saturday, I attended Trent Millet's "Dowsing In the Age of Consciousness". He spoke about having a conscious choice of listening and speaking from the Heart, of being aware and connected. The scope of dowsing is expanding to encompass accessing your inner knowledge and outer universal knowledge. He said that we are all aware and our mind-field is alive. Dowsing in the age since 12/21/2012 means utilizing our own knowing and connection even to the point of realizing our own telepathy minus the earthly ego and emotional interference. Trent is the president of the Mohawk-Hudson Dowsers and teaches dowsing and Radionics. I really enjoyed Trent's workshop and talked with him at length afterwards. He would love to be invited to our Southern Region Conference.

The keynote speaker for Saturday night was Paxton Robey, held in a beautiful auditorium. Paxton spoke from a director's chair in rather laid back fashion. In fact he started off by saying: "I walk slow, and I speak slow, so if you can adjust to me, I think you will find it worth your while." I did have to allow my mind to quiet after the day's activities, so I could drink in every word. Part of his technique, I think, was to get you to do that. Otherwise, you would have got up and left. His presentation was entitled "Who are you? What Are You Doing Here?" He spoke of our laying out a plan and a purpose for this life; however we may have forgotten most of it. Now we remember that we are not merely human, we are unlimited. As we uncover the 'big picture' of the Universe and the role we play, we discover the divine service we make available to mankind. We have felt the magnificent energy which moves through us as we dowse for answers. This energy is the tip of the iceberg, Paxton explained. He then went on to explore what lies ahead. I was deeply

moved by his talk in that it confirmed a lot of lifetime effort to follow my heart. I would love to invite him to our conference.

Sunday morning I started off with Christina Lynn Whited and her workshop entitled: "Photographing the Fifth Dimension." Since I am a lifelong photographer, and having met her in the vendor area, I just couldn't miss it. Christina explained how the level of each person's development dictates what they will receive via the camera. I was fascinated by the various pictures of orbs, fairies, and other phenomena that she and her students were able to capture. She showed us the amazing story of inter-dimensional as well as intergalactic love and support for the people of Earth. A lot of photos were taken near a waterfall near High Point, NJ. She told us that this particular waterfall was a galactic portal, one of only 13 in the world. These phenomena are especially visible around the time of the solstices. Christina's gift of channeling, awakened through dowsing, enables her to be able to describe the images in detail, in other-worldly terms, way beyond orbs. I would love to have her and her talented photographers at our conference for a workshop. She has national recognition with folks like Dr. Wayne Dyer, and Dr Joe Vitale.

Aaron Singleton was my next workshop, entitled "Restore Your Divine Blueprint." Aaron is a Healer-Visionary who brings all new Biomorphic Geometry (BMG) prototypes from the super-consciousness realm. BMG is art specifically created to help us evolve faster than ever before, experiencing rapid, ongoing energy shifts, sometimes daily. Aaron demonstrates how our DNA reads and interprets biomorphic patterns and shifts imbalances/stuck energy. Unlike traditional sacred geometry patterns, BMG patterns help us to achieve rapid permanent change like never before. During the workshop, he performed several healings and polled the participants to see if it was working for them. It was amazing to hear the answers. I was really curious about his work after the workshop, so I ask him for help with my knees. After a few minutes, he asked me to stand up and my pain level went from an 8 to 0. I thought that I could use some of his techniques in my own practice so I purchased some cards and information.

At lunch time, I met Raymon Grace and he asked me if I had seen Federico Marincola yet. I said no, and he

suggested that I come to the workshop with him after lunch. Federico was a friend of Raymon's and from Italy. It turns that he was responsible for getting Raymon to the convention. The room was packed, I was glad I came early. His workshop was called "Radionics Without Borders." In somewhat broken English, he spoke and was very engaging. The aim of his project is to make Radionics available to the rest of the world (especially to people with limited financial resources who don't have money to buy medicines.) He spoke about his mission in Nicaragua, Honduras, and Guatemala, where he teaches dowsing, the five levels of Radionics, the techniques of Raymon Grace, hands-on healing, etc. Up to now he has had very good results. He explained the project in detail and showed various beautiful photos of his adventures in Central America.

Next, he spoke of H. O. Busby (1878-1969,) an Australian dowser who developed a unique system of "charging" pebbles, with the help of self made graphics containing what he called a "Cosmic Number." Mr. Busby used those pebbles in a variety of situations, with EXCELLENT results (in agriculture, for the protection of the human beings, etc.) With these "Busby Pebbles" we can channel most of the energies that can be detected with our dowsing. During the lecture, Federico taught how to create a "Cosmic Number" graphic, to charge some simple stones and create the "Busby Pebbles" that can channel the required energy. His talk was very well received and I talked to him afterwards about coming to our conference next year. Being a friend of Raymon helps.

The weekend ended with Raymon Grace's keynote presentation which was lively and entertaining as always. Again, the auditorium was packed witnessing Raymon using his bobber to effect change for those in the audience and I think the Universe. All in all, it was a wonderful convention and I am really grateful for our Chapter for its support, which allowed me to experience it. I relatively new to dowsing, compared to some of you, and I would suggest that if you really want to find out what is going in the wide world of dowsing, attend a convention, especially the ASD national in Vermont. There are also conventions in the Southwest, and California. Soon we will have our chance to make a difference in our lives and others with our own convention.

From I-40: Exit 53A (in east Asheville) to Highway 74 S east. Go 5.2 miles towards Fairview.

R on Emmas Grove Rd . Go 1.4 mi. R on Bob Barnwell Rd. Go 1/2 mi. Turn L at mailbox #137.

From I-26: use Exit 44 (Fletcher/Mtn. Home), turn onto Hwy 25 North. Go about 3 mi to Cane Creek Rd. on the right (there is traffic light at the intersection). Turn R, go to 2nd light. Continue on Cane Creek Rd. for 2.7 mi., turn L on Concord Rd. Go 2/10 mi. Turn R on Gravely Branch Rd. Go to end. Turn R on Emmas Grove Rd. Go 1 mile and turn a sharp L on Bob Barnwell Rd. In Memoriam – Peter Calhoun

[Editor's note: For thirty-plus years Peter Calhoun inspired and guided people in how to re-establish their connection with Earth and reclaim their Spiritual Powers. Using the tools of shamanism, he has helped people to experience wholeness, unity, joy, and love through personal connection to the Infinite Divine. Peter passed over to the spirit world on July 21.



Peter spoke to a standing-room-only crowd at our first program in Unity Center, in February 2009. Based on the success of that visit, he established Asheville as one of his operating bases, and we considered him a great friend of the Chapter. Peter's books include *Soul On Fire*, *Life Without Limits*, and the newly-released *Last Hope on Earth* (all available at Amazon.com). Below is a letter his long-time partner, Astrid Ganz, sent out to their email network on July 26 (edited slightly for space).]

My beloved husband, friend, and confidant passed away Sunday evening - during the energy of the full moon. I miss him more than I can say because he was everything to me, and there are moments when I think I cannot go on without him. He and I had an experience together that I do not expect to be duplicated while I remain on this Earth. However, with help and encouragement from many friends, I know I am going to carry our work forward as best I can by publishing our remaining books and by continuing to share the technique of Transformational Healing with as many people as possible through workshops and other avenues. I know it was his passionate desire that this healing technology become available far and wide.

Peter had such a unique sensitivity to all living things which gave him a deep insight into many situations and what was needed for each, whether it was a healing for a person or a healing for the Earth. Because of the depth of his compassion, he would often push himself beyond his limit in order to be a helping influence. Over the course of many years, through his writings, his speaking, his teaching, his healings, and the overflowing love of his heart, Peter has left a giant footprint for good on this planet. It was the sheer power of his will to serve that actually brought him to the brink of death on more than one occasion when it seemed he was gone. It was these previous returns that gave us hope that he might pull through again this time, but it was not to be so.

Our associate Robert G. Fritchie, Director of the World Service Institute, recently agreed to finalize the editing and then publish our most recent book on our Transformational Healing technology, entitled *Last Hope on Earth*. As if this weren't enough, Bob also freely invested many hours of his own time to give *Life Without Limits* an updated editing. Thank you, Bob, from the bottom of my heart!

From several sources I have come to know that Peter is in a state of great joy in the other dimensions where he now resides. I have received clear indications that he smiles upon and agrees with our efforts to proceed with this work, and that he continues to be by my side as well.

We love and appreciate all of you who have touched our hearts and have allowed us to touch yours through our books, gatherings, and private healing sessions. A special thanks to all of you, also, who have so graciously contributed your time and talents to assist us. And although I have never met some of you, I know that we were all brought together by a Love that is greater than any of us can fully comprehend.


Member's Corner
**Creating Harmonic-chord Cosmic Energy Essences
at the 2013 National ASD Convention**

[Editor's note: this article describes how three bottled energy essences, representing three different intentions, were created at the ASD conference from 88 source essences. Those source essences contained mainly energies from various crop circles. According to the author each crop circle was created by one of the star sources (Arcturan, Pleiadean etc.), and the specific source and details of the energy of each essence were channeled from the Akashic Records by Aingeal Rose O'Grady, a spiritual channel in Arizona. We present a somewhat shortened version of Brian's original article here, with the caveat that the truth of the information is not known with absolute certainty at this time. Readers who are knowledgeable and experienced in accurate pendulum dowsing may be able to determine its validity for themselves. Brian Crissey is VP of App Chapter.]

Perhaps 600 dowsers from around the nation converged on the campus of Lyndon State College, Vermont, from June 5-11 to hear many speakers and to partake of many workshops, all on various aspects of dowsing. Your faithful vice-president spoke in the main classroom on Friday, June 6 on "Communication with Extraordinary Beings by Dowsing and Decoding Crop Circles." It was well received. What follows is an account of life in the vendors' gym as three new harmonic chord essence-beings were birthed, with the assistance of many dowsers.

Day One



88 cobalt-blue bottles stood in uneven rows on the table. To one side, a multicolored swirl lay beneath seven more bottles. A two-ounce bottle anchored the center, while six more one-ounce bottles circled it, one centered on each of the six symmetric arms of the Global Healing Mandala, whose design was derived intuitively from a remarkable crop formation that appeared in England's Milk Hill field just before 9/11. It was created in four hours of darkness, in the driving rain, without footprints. To any but the foolish or stubborn, the design was not made by hands, and the Global Healing Mandala is now recognized by those who have used it as a potent intention-focusing tool to manifest reality. It was used in 20 nations to help manifest a better world on 12/21/12.

Beside the array of bottles was a ballot on which attendees voted on 25 possible new "universal" essences that might be created next. The list was transcribed by Aingeal Rose O'Grady, author of *A Time of Change: Akashic Guidance for Spiritual Transformation*. One essence was to be created each day at the conference. The one created on day 1 intends to protect people from the ill effects of GMOs and to reconfigure the DNA of affected plants, returning them to their natural pristine DNA states. Next in line for Saturday was an essence intended "to help the elderly, especially those who are old and alone." Sunday's creation, determined by Saturday's cumulative votes, intends to support the incoming special children, the Crystals and Rainbows. We live in an intentionally manifested world, and we can and will create these essences.



Visitors to the booth were invited to dowse the 88 possible candidates to identify six for inclusion in the new "recipe." Source suggests that we limit to six the number of component essences in any new composite essence. The 88 candidates are like keys on a piano, and creating a new composite essence is like inventing a new harmonic chord, never before heard by human ears. The difference, of course, is that the selection of keys is dowsed rather than played.

One essence that is always included is 0101, the afore-mentioned Global Healing Mandala, which is the mixing bowl, binder and stove that turns the raw recipe and components into a delicious energy confection.




Next to be dowsed for inclusion was 1221, New Dawn, a composite essence created by a three-day Turning of the Ages gathering in Western North Carolina around 12/21. It intends to manifest and sustain what the ancient Hopis called the 5th World. Its Akashic Record reading says, "This is undoubtedly the Mandala of life, living, joy, and happiness. Use this essence to achieve instant manifestation for things that belong to this higher order. We cannot

effectively fight Monsanto with anger, but we can manifest a world so high in joyful frequency that ideas like growing pesticides inside our foods will not be allowed to even surface.



Next came 1002, Inner Resonance, an Arcturian essence that, according to the Akashic Records, "harmonizes you and promotes wellness, adjusting your hormonal imbalances and integrating your higher and lower chakras, balancing the male-female differences. It helps you understand unity, enabling you to see the infinite, but opposite, potential on each side of different realities."

The fourth component dowsed out to be 0705, The Dawn of Creation, a Pleiadian-Arcturian formation that "represents the process of creation. This essence can open up and stimulate your creativity and show you your potential. Much more is possible than your limited thoughts of what could be."




We are collectively choosing to create a GMO-free world. An interesting "coincidence" was the intense radiation level recorded inside this agriglyph. Radiation modifies DNA, while the GMO problem is modified genetics. It seems these two players play on the same ball field. This one was probably a meaningful choice.

The next essence dowsed from the 88 included another surprise: 0804, Estarra, a Pleiadean formation that appeared next to a wind rotor and looked like three interacting cogwheels. It is "a very powerful essence! It is a



powerful force for moving things onward that have been dormant or stuck for a long time.... On a personal level, it will move you out of "stuckness" by causing the changes necessary for forward progress. It ratchets up your awareness, consciousness, and spiritual frequencies for the great shift. It balances body, mind and spirit." The surprise was not that this essence was selected out the 88 choices, which can be expected with a probability of 1/88. The surprise was that the next dowser *also* selected Estarra, an event that occurs naturally only once in every 7744 trials, a very high level of statistical significance.

In the final minutes, the six dowsed candidate bottles were placed in the circle and four dowsers, Brian, Richard, Nancy and Holly, entered into sacred circle. The breathed love energy into their heart chakras, and spun the Global Healing Mandala gently in their minds' eyes, drawing in violet transformative energy from far above, and rich, green, loving Earth energy from far below. These energies mixed and swirled in the center, distributing out along the great symmetric arms, sweeping through the dowsers' energy fields, cleansing and empowering them, and causing the receptive waters to permanently remember the group intention of returning to a GMO-free world.



Each of the four dowser "parents" was given a bottle of the newly born 1307, "GMO-free," a powerful ally in our collective effort to wrest this beautiful free-will planet from the grasp of self-serving powers that would harm us and the sustainable world we intend to pass on to future generations. This newborn "child" came without instructions, except for the mysterious but reliable guidance that comes from across the Quantum Edge, when one inquires within.

Day Two

Visitors to the table were invited to dowse ingredients for a new harmonic-chord cosmic energy essence "to help the elderly, especially those who are old and alone." This choice was a clear front-runner among the voting dowsers on day one of the conference. The first ingredient was the mainstay, 0101, the Global Healing Mandala, which mixes, glues and manifests intention.



Next came 1008, Evolution of the Species, a Mayan-spirit contribution that helps one "cope with the everlasting cycle of change and connect back to Source and experience the interconnectedness of all life." This essence seems to be appropriate for elders, helping them to cope with change and feel included and appreciated again.

The third essence dowsed by the attendees was 0506, The Language of Love, a very loving Arcturian formation. It "stimulates DNA in people who are really asleep, awakens DNA potential and parts of the body that are not turned on." Elders often lack invigorating love-based stimuli, and their bodies begin to weaken, so this ingredient seems a good fit.



The fourth dowsed ingredient was 0511, Love in Action, a Sirian formation whose essence "emits a very nurturing feeling. It is very feminine. It supplies you with love in many ways, whatever you need. It is like mother's milk. It is for healing. It restores your self-acceptance and it allows you to be more loving."



Fifth to be dowsed into the recipe was 0303, Radiance, a solar contribution from the Sun People that "upgrades one's perception to a higher frequency and changes the crystalline structure in the mind and brain, upgrading one's eye 'sight' and inner knowing.



The final ingredient to be included was 0509, Coming Home, a Pleiadean formation whose essence helps adults who have had traumatized childhoods.

In the final minutes of the day, six heart-centered people gathered in sacred circle to draw in a multitude of higher spirits to activate the newly born harmonic-chord essence, temporarily named "Companion."

Day Three

The voice of the dowsers was very clear about which cosmic chord to design next: "an essence to support the Indigo, Crystal and Rainbow children to be able to flourish in this dimension, unencumbered and unhindered." According to Aingeal, the Indigos have been incarnating for 50 to 100 years to accelerate our evolution. "They are very pure and innocent, but have much knowledge and wisdom." Many of us are Indigos.

"The Crystal children carry a completely different harmonic frequency than the Indigos. More of their harmonics are turned on, and they exhibit greater gifts of creativity, especially in music, sports and invention. The Rainbow children are "Holy children from far outside of our galaxy, like little avatars. There are not many here yet, because our consciousness must rise first. They will anchor *peace* into this planet." Our chapter Secretary, Nancy Baumgarten, has been working with special "psy-kids," who are probably Rainbow kids. The dowsers selected exactly four ingredients for this recipe, and 0101 was the first, of course. Then came the Arcturian 0503, Tree of Life, whose pyramidal design "affects the crystalline structure of the Earth. It can be used deliberately to affect the crystalline structure of plants, humans and minerals."

The second ingredient was the Pleiadean 0509, Coming Home, whom we met earlier, but this time the pertinent part of the reading "has to do with repairing childhood traumas."

The final ingredient was 1205, Star Mission, from the Star Collective, a relatively new group of players on our stage. Aingeal reports that "there is a force pulling the Earth to new coordinates in the multidimensional time-space continuum, changing our entire field. This essence realigns your own light body and physiology to Earth's new coordinates."



At day's end, a dozen heart-centered dowsers gently circled heart-centered energy through the Great Healing Mandala, drawing in transformative, cosmic energies from above and pulling up healing and loving green Earth energies from below. The essence to assist the new children was created.
